## Who's Who: CREATIVE

JULIEN NITZBERG (Lyricist, Writer and Director)

Like Grandmaster Flash, Stanley Kubrick and David Berkowitz, Julien Nitzberg was raised in the Bronx. At age 16, he was a founding member of the cult New York hardcore punk band Artless. Playing noise guitar, Nitzberg was known for frequently mocking racist skinhead members of the audience. This seemed fun until the night when Artless were opening for legendary hardcore band Minor Threat and Nitzberg got pulled off the stage and stomped by a gang of skinheads. After several steel toed boot kicks to the head, Nitzberg was pulled back on stage bleeding. Despite his injuries, he immediately went back to mocking the Nazis and hasn't stopped to this day. The son of a Holocaust survivor, Nitzberg grew up in a family that saw the worst of humanity which resulted in his nihilistic love for pushing the envelope by combining black comedy and scathing social commentary. In the world of theater, Nitzberg wrote and directed the controversial comic operetta *The Beastly Bombing or* A Terrible Tale of Terrorists Tamed By The Tangles Of True Love. It was dubbed by the Huffington Post "the first great work of comedy to emerge from the post-9/11 little planet of horrors." It was staged in Los Angeles, New York, Chicago and Amsterdam and won the LA Weekly Theater Critics Musical of the Year Award. In the world of film, Nitzberg is best known as the producer and director of the documentary feature The Wild and Wonderful Whites of West Virginia. This film about a family infamous for criminality and tap dancing was the first non-Jackass feature produced by Johnny Knoxville. The film was distributed theatrically by Robert DeNiro's company Tribeca Film and was shown on Showtime and Netflix. He has also written scripts for HBO, Showtime, Amazon Films, TNT, USA, IFC, Paramount Studios, CBS Studios and NBC. He was a producer and writer on Cinemax's animated series Mike Judge Presents Tales From the Tour Bus. Most recently, Nitzberg got a two season commitment from Tubi for the animated series Breaking Bear about a family of grizzlies who start selling meth and become drug kingpins in an effort to save their forest from fracking. It will debut in 2023.

## NICOLE MORIER (Composer)

Multi-platinum songwriter Nicole "Coco" Morier has been absorbing musical styles her whole life: Early influences of folk and country from her singersongwriter father led to teenage explorations of garage rock and punk followed by the avant-garde electronic scene in Berlin with her band *Electrocute*, a tour as Charlotte Gainsbourg's lead guitarist, and ultimately success as a singersongwriter and producer in L.A. She's composed songs for Britney Spears (5 songs over 3 albums, one of which *How I Roll* was recently named by Rolling Stone her #3 best song of all time). She's also co-penned numerous hits for the likes of Icona Pop, Demi Lovato, Ellie Goulding, Selena Gomez, Big Freedia, Tom Jones, Ava Max, Rina Sawyama and Hayley Kiyoko to name a few. Her co-writes have topped the charts in Sweden, Germany and Australia, as well as a #1 U.S Billboard Dance chart smash Wynter Gordon's *Dirty Talk*. Morier's compositions and productions have landed over 300 placements in film, television, and video games including *Spongebob Squarepants Movie*, *Pitch* 

Perfect 2, Queer Eye, Kung Fu Panda, BH90210, Broad City, Grey's Anatomy, Mistresses, Genera+ion, Woke, Lucifer, Fifa, and The Sims. She co-penned an updated pop reboot of the Super Mario Brothers Theme Song called We Are Born To Play featuring Galantis and Charli XCX for the new Super Nintendo Theme Park in Tokyo. In 2022 she won a Juno Award Best Rock Album for her contributions to The Beaches album Sisters Not Twins (The Professional Lovers Album). Her song Days and Years landed on the Princes of K-Pop SHINee's 2021 album Atlantis which debuted at number #1 in 26 countries.

**DREW ERICKSON** (Composer)

Drew Erickson is an American musician, composer, songwriter, arranger, and record producer; best known for his collaborations with Weyes Blood, Tim Heidecker, Bret Mckenzie, Father John Misty, Lana Del Rey, Angel Olsen, Jonathan Wilson, & Roger Waters.

MAX TOWNSLEY (Composer)

Max Townsley is a multi-instrumentalist, composer, songwriter and singer based in Dallas, Texas. He has toured the globe as a guitarist extensively with the bands Midlake and Neon Indian. He composed and performed the music for the feature film *Song Of The Cicada*. As a songwriter he has penned songs for Keith Urban and Sabrina Claudio. His vocals were featured in the first episode of the HBO series *Generation*. Max also works as a session musician, playing guitar and keyboards on many musical projects.

**ANTHONY "TONY" JONES** (*Producer*)

Tony Jones was there the day the young Jackson brothers drove to Detroit from Gary, Indiana and set foot inside Motown for the first time. Soon after, he became the coordinator for "all things" Jackson 5. Little did the world know that within a year these brothers also would be championed by Diana Ross and catapult to fame on the stages of The Ed Sullivan Show singing I Want You Back. Anthony "Tony" Jones began his career at Motown Records. Working with Suzanne de Passe, and, as a result, closely with Founder and Chairman, Berry Gordy. He was instrumental in guiding the careers of a number of Motown acts as they became superstars. The Jackson 5, The Jacksons and Michael as a solo artist were great beneficiaries working with the management and creative direction of Tony both in front of and behind the scenes. He worked closely with Diana Ross during her solo career at Motown. Tony played a key role in Michael Jackson's solo albums and performances when he appeared without his brothers during their Motown years. He became a Talent Manager working with Billy Preston, Syreeta, De Barge and Jermaine Jackson, and, also Jennifer Holiday during her historic Broadway appearance as Effie in *Dream Girls* for which she won both a Tony and a Grammy Award. Tony was an Executive Producer of *Motown 40: The Music is Forever*, the award winning The Jackson's: An American Dream and the Lonesome Dove television series among other television productions. He is currently in pre-production on

three projects. Tony is producing the unscripted reality series *Lords of The Valley* - about the affluent, fun-loving, culturally rich Armenian community that sweeps the lavish landscape of San Fernando Valley, Los Angeles. *Tumbleweed Connection* - is an original musical set to Elton John's album of the same name. The book and concept are by Chris Khan who is joined by Jones and the producers of the Tony Award winning musical *Come From Away*. And of course, *For The Love Of A Glove* - an original musical celebrating Michael Jackson's early life and career by Julien Nitzberg.

#### LEIGH R. CRAWFORD (Producer)

Leigh is the founder of Crawford Capital LLC, which provides investment and advisory services. He studied Mathematics and English Literature at UC Berkeley and Claremont McKenna College, where he is co-founder and Chair of the Center for Human Rights. Born in Rio de Janeiro, Brasil with a mother in show business, he has a lifelong love of theatre. He produced *Sneaux!* at the Matrix, and has been a patron of CTG, Rogue Machine and 24th St. Theatre. He has two daughters, Savvy Crawford and Lilla Crawford, both actors based in New York.

BETSY ZAJKO (Producer, Assistant Director, Puppet Translator)

Betsy's first experience as a performer was getting upstaged by The O'Jays at a talent show in Jr High. Her first film role was with Bruce Willis and her last TV role was a scene with Al Pacino, in between she's acted alongside Larry David, Allison Janney, Sherilyn Fenn, Richard Gere, Melissa McCarthy, so the bucket list is nearly complete. Saying yes to anything she likes has led to a unique career in radio, acting, puppetry and producing. During her tenure in broadcast news at CBS and NPR, she was producer for Harvey Pekar of American Splendor, and hosted the national program A Change of Season. She directed Felicia Michaels' comedy special on Amazon Prime, and for four years produced Rant & Rave at Rogue Machine where she'll produce June Carryl's Proud Boy this April. Acting credits: Steppenwolf, Cleveland Playhouse, Trap Door, Odyssey Theatre, Rubicon Theatre, Son of Semele Ensemble. OK K.O. Cartoon Network; Masters of Sex, Showtime; Curb Your Enthusiasm, HBO; Mike and Molly, CBS; Body of Proof, NBC. Awards/Nominations: Associated Press, Women In Journalism, Society for Professional Journalists, The Jeff Awards, Ovations, The LA Weekly, and The LA Drama Critics' Circle. Look for her in the documentary series The Liegnitz Plot and in the season 2 premiere of *Hunters*. Most recently she was the annoying wife in the wildly popular commercial Shingles can be Whaaat?!? that hit 12 millions views in a week, with fan remixes on YouTube that got her invited to Cameo. Her work as a puppeteer and fabrication technician for a Jim Henson quadruped animatronic Saber Toothed Cat at the La Brea Tar Pits is what got Julien to lure her into this wild ride. ## BURK ZANFT (Producer)

Burk Zanft was raised in the musical theater community by a mother whose career as a Radio City Rockette was tragically cut short when she became pregnant with Burk. In the womb, she began programming Burk with a love of

musical theater by holding a boombox up to her stomach playing an endless loop of the soundtracks to *A Chorus Line* and *Kiss of the Spider Woman*. Fulfilling his mother's dreams, as a young man he starred in acclaimed productions of *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat* and *West Side Story*. After a brief time running for office in the ugly world of South Florida politics, he decided to return to his first love by becoming a producer in the less ugly world of musical theater. This is his first L.A. production.

CRIS JUDD (Choreographer)

This multi-faceted artist came from humble beginnings born in Abilene, Texas and raised in the Philippines, Hawaii and Florida before eventually finding his way to Los Angeles. At the age of 21, Judd challenged himself to become a professional dancer within one year. He received his first contract at Walt Disney World's Pleasure Island within 8 months and hasn't looked back since. In 1995 he was chosen to dance with Michael Jackson for the MTV Video Music Awards, which led to him dancing with Jackson on Dangerous and HIStory world tours. He started his choreography career when he was asked to choreograph the 1999 summer tour for Jordan Knight. Cris also directed the music video, Ain't It Funny-Remix with Ja Rule and was the creative director and choreographer for Jennifer Lopez's NBC concert special Let's Get Loud filmed in Puerto Rico. Cris has been currently choreographing numerous multi camera tv shows from Lopez vs Lopez, Bob Hearts Abishola, That Girl Lay Lay, Villains of Valley View and Erin and Aaron just to name a few. Cris is working towards eventually becoming a director.

CHRISTOPHER MOSCATIELLO (Music Director and Sound Designer) Recipient of the 2015 Stage Raw award and 2014 Ovation nomination for sound design, Christopher Moscatiello is a composer, music director and sound editor/mixer for theater, television and film. Recent television credits include The Walking Dead (AMC), Eureka (SyFy), Human Target (Fox), Psych (USA), Caprica (SyFy), The Cape (NBC), Trauma (NBC), and he has scored full series for National Geographic and Discovery Channel, as well as specials and promos for HBO, Animal Planet, MSNBC, The History Channel, The Learning Channel, BBC, and ZDF Germany. Theater credits include The Kennedy Center, Arena Stage, The Folger Shakespeare Theater, The Smithsonian Institution, Rogue Machine Theatre, Odyssey Theatre Ensemble, Antaeus Theatre Company, Skylight Theatre Company, Pacific Resident Theatre and The Road Theater. An East Coast native, Chris spent several years in Boston as Associate Artistic Director and Conductor of the Boston Chamber Ensemble. During that period, he wrote a ballet commissioned by the Kirov Ballet Academy that had its world premiere in Washington, DC. Also while on the East Coast, he was the production music director for the theater program at American University, and the supervising composer for The Washington Opera's Create and Produce program. He also served as Master Sound Engineer for the Washington Folklore Society Folk Festival, Staff Engineer at Wooden Nickel Sound and Recording, and as Technical Director for The Stage Door theater program in Arlington, Va.

ANDREA KELLER (Production Designer)

Andrea Keller is an acclaimed architect and interior designer who has reimagined and designed major spaces for the W Hotel Westwood, the Mondrian Hotel Los Angeles and the London West Hollywood. Needing an expert at period details, the Hearst Family hired Andrea to replicate the distinctive Hearst architecture style of the 1920's when she built the Hearst Ranch Store on the Hearst Castle property. Recently she designed the Moss Theatre at the New Roads School as well as the A Noise Within Theatre in Pasadena. Andrea has taught at Otis College of Design, USC School of Architecture and lectures on Architectural History for the Institute of Classical Architecture. Her firm is AKA Architecture + Design in Downtown LA.

**RONALD BINION** (Lead Puppet Builder)

Ron Binion is a Los Angeles based Puppet Artist. He trained as a puppeteer at the Center for Puppetry Arts in Atlanta, Georgia. He puppeteered the character "Pixel" on the children's television show Lazy Town. Recently Ronald puppeteered on the film Ghostbusters: Afterlife. In addition to doing puppetry for theater, television and film, He has also worked with humanitarian organizations in East Africa and South East Asia to create films and live presentations that use puppetry to communicate messages of health, prevention and social change.

**DERRICK McDANIEL** (*Lighting Designer*)
Derrick McDaniel has been working in the live theater arena for over 20 years, both in Los Angeles and New York. From *Romeo and Juliet* to *Guys and Dolls*, Derrick has designed lighting for many plays, musicals and events. A few of his lighting credits include: *Mercy Seat* (2012 LA Weekly Awards Winner) at the Inside the Ford Theater, Death House at the Road Theatre on Lankershim, Spring Awakening at the Whitefire Theatre, The Addams Family at the Madrid Theater; and Freud's Last Session at the Odyssey Theater.— and many others. Derrick is an award-winning designer and has been nominated for several Ovation Awards, as well. Recently, he was nominated for an NAACP Theater Award for Les Blanc at the Rogue Machine Theater.

ANN CLOSS-FARLEY (Costume Designer)

Ann Closs-Farley designs costumes across the country and around the world for film, theater, television, opera, and print. Credits include: The Pee-wee Herman Show (Broadway), Toy Story The Musical (Disney), What About Dick?
